To ensure a mix of students essential to Nicotra Charter's success, separate lotteries will be conducted for special education and general education students. Incoming students are selected through a lottery, in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act. All applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list.

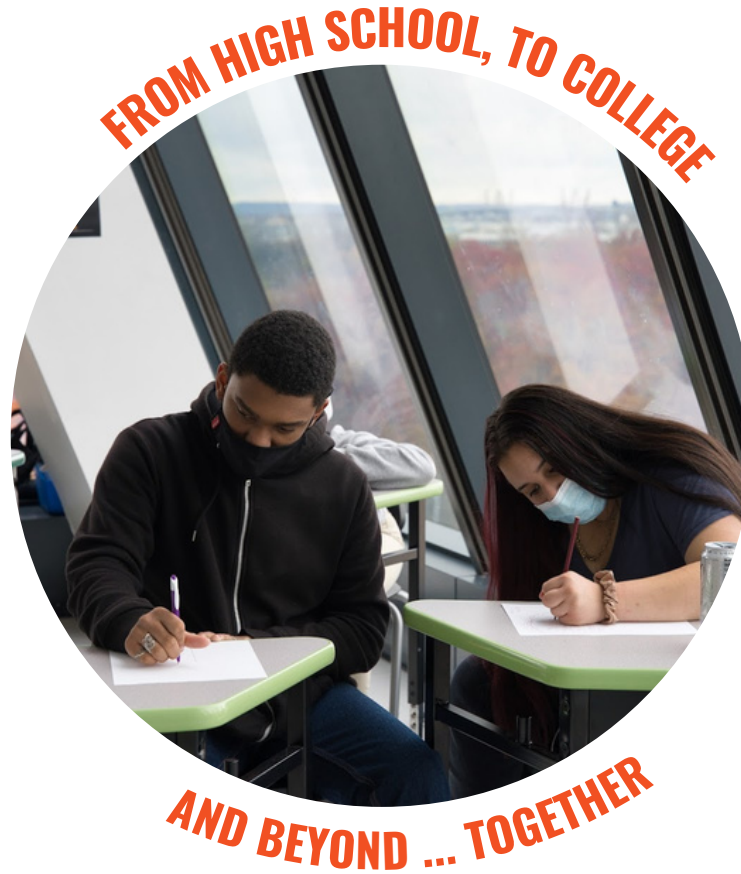
- All students residing in New York State are eligible to attend Nicotra Early College Charter School.

OUR ACCELERATED PATHWAY TO COLLEGE GRADUATION

NICOTRA CHARTER IS DIVIDED INTO TWO PHASES:

COLLEGE PREPARATION AND EARLY COLLEGE OR CAREER COLLEGE PREPARATION PHASE (GRADES 8-10):

Students are enrolled in accelerated Regents-level high school courses designed to prepare them for college as they earn a high school diploma.

EARLY COLLEGE PHASE:

Eligible students study on the St. John's University Grzymes Hill campus and earn credits in both core and pathway courses.



CAREER PHASE:

Students who are not eligible for Early College or wish to select the careers option participate in our internship program, alternating academic study with immersive work experience in their field of study.

CAREER PATHWAYS:

Students choose one of three pathways: Education, Business and Entrepreneurship or Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice.
